

Major in History (42 credits)

This program will apply to all students entering the History Major program <u>from Fall 2022 forwards</u>. For students admitted to the History Major before Fall 2022, see the document "Major in History (42 credits), 2015-2022."

The History Major requires 42 credits at introductory, intermediate, and advanced levels, exploring different fields of history through breadth requirements. The credits for the Major are distributed in this way:

3 Credits HIST 200 Introduction to History

HIST 200 is a First Year Seminar on a focused topic (a "deep dive" into a historical subject) that introduces students to how historians make arguments, how they use historical evidence and other scholars' writing, and how they communicate their ideas. There are several sections of HIST 200 offered in the Fall and Winter terms, each with a different

topic.

6 Credits HIST courses at the 300 or 400 level

24-Credit and General Education rules

In addition to your History credits, you must take at least <u>24</u> elective credits, including <u>6</u> General Education credits (courses outside the Humanities sector – e.g. in Social Science or in Science).
