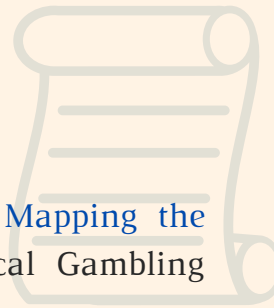
The interview with Edward
