

# AUTHORIZATION TO PICK-UP A DIPLOMA ON SOMEONE'S BEHALF

#### **Enrolment Services**

In accordance with the Quebec Act Respecting Access to Documents Held by Public Bodies and the Protection of Personal Information, Concordia University is required to obtain consent from current and former students in respect of requests for the release of personal information, including diplomas. To designate a proxy to collect on your behalf:

- I. Complete and sign the form.
- 2. Upload the completed form to your Student Centre, using the <u>Upload Document feature</u> and select Document Type: *Diploma Pick Up Authorization*.
- 3. Verify that the document is available in your Student Centre. It could take up to 24 hours to appear.
- Once the document appears in your Student Centre, inform the third party who is picking up your diploma of their obligations, including:
  - a. Presenting a valid photo identification. Digital versions of identifications are not accepted.
  - b. Present a printed copy of this completed and signed form.
