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## Description

General Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for work in Faculty of Fine Arts

The word "Laboratory" in this document includes, laboratories, shops, venues, galleries etc.

#### **Procedures**

#### **Step Description**

- 1 Prior starting work in laboratory/shop/venue
  - Do not work alone.
  - Review area guidelines concerning use of evacuation, equipment, behavior and conduct, food, incident/near miss reporting, signage etc.
  - Ensure that you are properly attired
  - Remove and put aside any personal devices such as cellphones, earbuds, or headphones
  - Wear your personal protective equipment (PPE) as required for your work area.
  - Ensure all safety/first aid/fire extinguishers/safety equipment is operational
  - Locate Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS)
  - Ensure that your workspace is clean.
  - Evaluate your project to ensure that you have adequate time for cleaning up.
- While working
  - Follow the approved procedures for your work and use of associated tools.

## **Step Description**

- 3 After work is done
  - Stop your work 10/20 minutes prior to end of working session to ensure that you have adequate time to cleanup.
  - Dispose hazardous waste according Concordia hazardous waste disposal policy
  - Dispose of other waste materials in a sustainable manner. Recycle or re-use discarded materials within the laboratory or through Concordia University Centre for Creative Reuse (CUCCR) <a href="http://www.cuccr.ca">http://www.cuccr.ca</a>
