Pregnancy Radiation Monitoring

Health Canada encourages processing your dosimeter badge every two weeks instead of every three months¹ during the course of your pregnancy. The National Dosimetry Service provides a Pregnancy Radiation Monitoring Service for pregnant workers where an additional dosimeter will be issued, to be worn on the abdomen, which will be submitted to the National Dosimetry Service every two weeks. If you decide to make use of this service, your radiation exposure will be reported every two weeks (abdomen) as well as every three months (usual location, torso or waist) for the course of your pregnancy.
