	CFL bulbs	See <u>concordia.ca/sustainability</u> for drop-off locations. Contact <u>sustainability@concordia.ca</u> to set up a CFL collection box at your office. Contact x4877 when full.
	Incandescent bulbs	These bulbs cannot be recycled. Safely dispose of them in the trash by wrapping them in a protective material such as several layers of newspaper.
- Base 1	Toner cartridges	Concordia Offices: Toner cartridges from internal Xerox machines are collected by DPrint. Contact x2400 for pick-up. Label boxes to: DPrint, S- LB018-3.
		Community: Look up your nearest Ecocentre.
	Batteries	See <u>concordia.ca/sustainability</u> for drop-off locations. Contact <u>sustainability@concordia.ca</u> to set up a battery collection box at your office. Contact x4877 when full.
	Small electronics and ink cartridges	Sell or donate working condition items. Try craigslist or kijiji. To recycle unusable ichargers, cables, peripherals, small electronics, and ink cartridges, drop off at the nearest electrobac bin (H 2nd, EV Basement, MB lobby, LB lobby, VL lobby)
	Desktops, monitors, laptops, etc.	For large electronic waste, contact IITS service desk at x7613 or help@concordia.ca to submit a request to discard equipment. Usable items will be wiped and reused internally or donated. Unusable items will be sent out for certified e-waste recycling. For items from home, see the list of city drop-off centers at concordia.ca/sustainability
